

14 days safari.marula.scandinavia.2012-13

Day 1: Moshi

Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport. To meet with a driver/guide, and then drive to Moshi Town, almost 45 min drive from the Airport to town for overnight.

Day 2: Kilimanjaro

Day trip to Kilimanjaro Mountain National Park, conduct a trail trek in the forest to the water falls. Thereafter, village excursions in the land slopes down to the legendary Lake Chala (an inland lake with underground rivers from mt. Kilimanjaro to Lake Jipe). Evening drive to Arusha town for overnight

Day 3: Arusha

Explore Arusha town, visit one of the cultural tourism enterprises, learn and experience the Maasai and Waarusha culture. Evening; after some shopping in Arusha we drive to Mto wa Mbu tourist town, adjacent to lake Manyara National Park. Overnight at the town

Day 4: Lake Manyara National Park

Early morning game drives in Lake Manyara National Park, Tanzania's most dramatically located wildlife area, consisting of a shallow but huge soda lake, at the foot of the Great Rift Valley's western escarpment. Lake Manyara is famous for its tree climbing lions. After lunch in town, we drive to Lake Miwaleni along the escarpment through some Maasai homes for spectacular view of the rift valley. Night at park cottages (to experience night life with some resident wildlife)

Day 5: Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Morning game drives in Lake Manyara national park again, afterwards drive through the Ngorongoro Conservation area, with spectacular Crater view on the way to the endless plains of the Serengeti. On this day it is possible to visit a Maasai Boma (kraal) to get more familiar with their daily life activities. Overnight at famous Serengeti National Park

Day 6 & 7: Serengeti National Park

Early morning game drives in Ndutu area. Ndutu has one of the best opportunities to see the cheetah, the rare African bat eared foxes and the Genet Cat. Afterwards we drive to Seronera Valley for a full day tour. Seronera is in Central Serengeti, the heart of wild Africa, a massive wilderness of up to 14'500/square km, where every day brings a new landscape and a new adventure

Day 8: Serengeti to Arusha through Ngorongoro Crater

Early morning we leave Serengeti for another chance to ascend the crater for a day trip (inside the crater we got opportunity to see the BIG FIVE (Lion, Leopard, the rare and endangered Black Rhino, Buffalo and Elephant) and massive number of water birds. From the crater we drive straight to Arusha town for overnight. (We will have chance to experience night life in this tourist town.)

Day 9: Arusha to Dar es Salaam

In this day we travel from the up northern circuit (upcountry) to the coast of the Indian Ocean with magnificent experiencing en-route, the different landscapes with magnificent sceneries. Spend overnight at a beach cottage in the city.

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Day 10: Dar es Salaam

In the morning we will have a City tour to get insight of the history of Tanzania, visit the National Museum and Archives; thereafter we drive off to historical town of Bagamoyo where the oldest missionaries history and remains can be found, also in this historical town we will have chance to learn the slave trade history, then drive back to Dar for an overnight in a 4 star hotel/lodge

Days 11-13: The Stone Town tour (Zanzibar Island)

We will take a boat to Zanzibar for a 3 days stone town and spice island tours. In Zanzibar we will have as much activities but mostly excursions and beach life! Accommodation in a 4 star hotel/lodge

Day 14: Zanzibar to Dar es Salaam

This is your travel day back to home; we will leave Zanzibar in the morning by boat, get to Dar for preparations of your international flight at the Mwalimu Nyerere International Airport in Dar es Salaam
